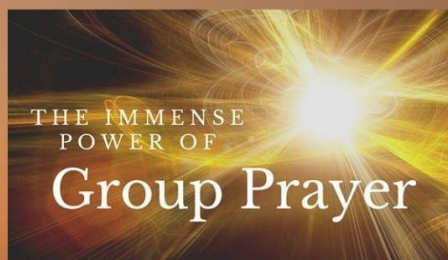

St. Patrick School will give a Pro-Life presentation. **Leah Maassel**, who serves for the CPC services in Northwest Ohio, will be discussing the impact of pregnancy centers & the power of a tiny heartbeat seen on the ultrasound. Representative **Craig Reidel** will talk about the current update regarding the Pro-Life legislation at the Statehouse & his faith life & family life where his mom was adopted.

**Ed Sitter**, executive of Foundation for Life, will speak concerning why now more than ever we need to be active in our defense of the unborn. The event will close with prayer by **Father Cirata**.
