





New Horizon Academy Principal

Marty is currently in his 42nd year in education. He started teaching in 1981 at Delta High School where he taught English for 24 years. As a teacher, he has received numerous awards and accolades throughout his career in education.

Marty served as the assistant principal at Delta High School before becoming the High School Principal there. He retired in 2016 from the district after 35 years of service. Marty then spent 1 1/2 years as the director of an at-risk youth program where he assisted young people in obtaining their high school degrees and getting job training and job placement.

In 2018, Marty became the Principal of New Horizons Academy in Wauseon. Marty was always drawn to the students who were overlooked or left out. The marginal children that struggled with physical, intellectual, or emotional deficits were typically drawn to him. In NHA, a school for children with Autism and multiple disabilities, Marty feels that he is where he was always meant to be.
