

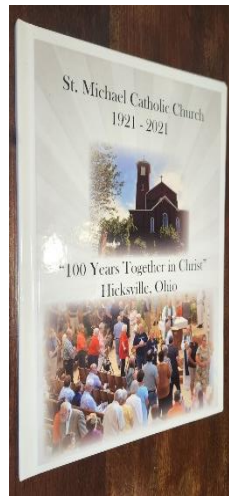

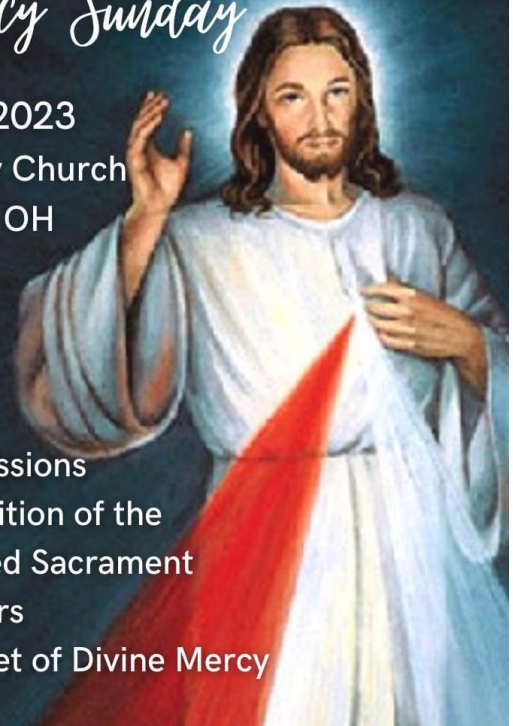
➤ **Right-to-Life Prayer Group** I hear babies crying in
