
We are planning to have 3 golf carts available for those who would like a ride.



The Pastoral Council met on Thursday, May 11, 2023, at 7:30 p.m.

The meeting was opened with prayer.

Present were: Father Dan Borgelt, Chairperson Cody Sanders, Secretary Diane Collins, Janet Langham, Judy McCalla and Bob Crites. Vicki Art, Ted Laker and Josh Vowels were absent.

<u>Minutes from the Last Meeting</u> – The March 9 minutes were approved as written.

**Finance** – An updated finance report was shared.

<u>Liturgy and Music</u> – Met May 7. a Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession will take place June 11.

**<u>K of C</u>** – Recently held a Mother's Day Breakfast.

<u>Altar Rosary Society</u> – Helping with food preparation for a graduation party; providing cookies for the May 21 brunch after church and for Wayne Thurman's Celebration of Life the same day; will have a breakfast for the 2023 graduates; will have a food booth at the Night of Lights; and planning to have a Father's Day breakfast.

**<u>CCD</u>** – Recently celebrated Confirmation and First Communion. A Children's Mass was held on April 30.

**<u>RCIA</u>** – Two people are taking the class at this time. Joni Slattery is helping.

### **Old Business:**

- Strategic Plan Printing the Strategic Plan and proposed banner stating our Sacred Purpose and Apostolic Values are still in the planning stages. Diane will request some designs for the banner.
- Stone on the outside of the church will be cleaned next weekend.
- Father will call the architect John Police for an update on the restroom renovation.
- CHRP 2.0 / welcome: continues to be on hold.
- FORMED –is an on-line faith formation resource. The renewal is coming up. The Diocese has the money to pay for half the fee.
- Church PA system The project should begin May 30/June 2. Father is looking for volunteers to help record Mass and other related jobs. There will be a camera mounted on the wall for Livestreaming.
- Living Christ: Endowment and Capital Campaign The Diocese is at 112% of its goal.
- Cody Sanders, Bob Crites and Ed Mendez will repair tiles and grout in the church.
- The parking lot needs work. Father will find out who the company is that last paved it.
- There may be some work needed on the church roof. Some parishioners think some shingles may be bad.

### **New Business:**

- There are some new parishioners. We are reach8ing out to them with a letter and a gift bag.
- It was suggested that people should call if they can't come to a council meeting.

### For the Good of the Cause:

- Ed Mendez is planning a Block Party on October 14. This will an outdoor event with food and activities.
- Susan Mack, member of the Hicksville Community Service Center board, contacted Fr. Dan about using the church during the summer. In lieu of the pool being closed, she is searching for other things for the children of the community to do. It sounds like she would like some time that the gym could be open for children to play, along with providing staffing. There was no discussion to speak of.
- Thursday, July 27 will be the summer cookout for the Finance and Pastoral Council. This will be for new and current members.
- The food stand was mentioned. This was well received last year. Plan to offer it again this summer.
- The council suggested the three money boxes be removed from church since the basket is being passed.
- Steph Mazur is giving up the Youth Ministry after several years. It was noted that her time was certainly appreciated. Paula and Rusty Campbell will be replacing Steph.
