Founding Fathers...Declaration of Independence...Inalienable Right

In the Preamble to the Declaration of Independence, Thomas Jefferson made it very clear that all human beings "are endowed by their Creator with certain inalienable rights". Chief and first among those he enumerated was the Right to Life.

Jefferson and our founding fathers knew that without the right to life, no other rights are possible. How can one have the right to vote or the right to free speech, for example, if one does not firstly have the right to exist?

The rights mentioned in the Declaration are no less valid than those articulated in our Constitution. In fact, they are foundational to all the rights and protections which the Constitution guarantees. This applies especially to the right to life, which is not only paramount but is also clearly protected under the 14th Amendment by due process of law.

We need to impress upon our children the importance of these two documents and how they already guarantee every American, born or unborn, weak or strong, the blessings of Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness.

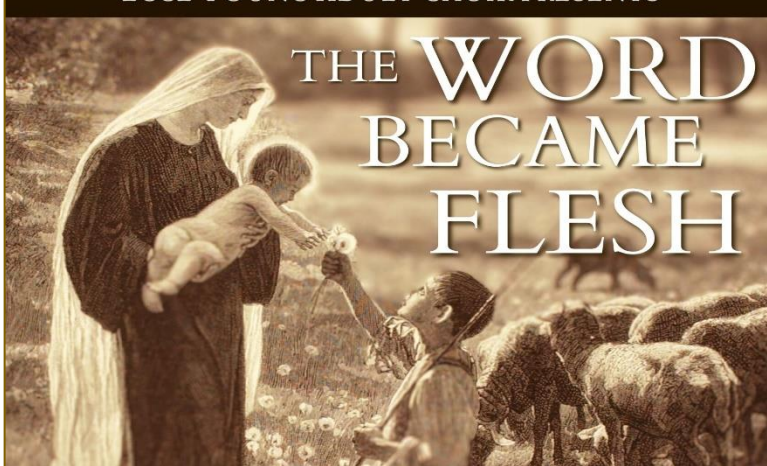

This week's Ministry Spotlight ~

CCD Teacher – What does CCD stand for? **C**onfraternity of **C**hristian **D**octrine. St. Michael's CCD Program serves pre-kindergarten through grade twelve. Classes are held on Wednesday evenings from mid-September to early May. Confirmation classes are held on Sunday mornings before Mass. The elementary program covers prayer, the Sacraments, the Commandments, Scripture (the Bible), the Mass, the Saints and more, with different areas stressed in each grade. The junior high program concentrates on the history and teachings of the Church and preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. The high school program varies from one grade to the next, but deals with morality, decision-making, and how to live as a good Catholic in today's world. Our catechists are "people who have answered the call of the community to be instruments of instruction, formation and transformation." Our CCD teachers are not professional teachers. "God doesn't call the 'qualified'; He qualifies those who He calls." We are always looking for volunteers to put in the time and effort to instruct our youth in the Catholic Faith. We also need Assistant Teachers. Some training may be required. To help, you need only a willingness to give and learn and share the Catholic Faith. God (and the CCD program) will provide you with the tools you need. We need teachers, helpers and substitutes. All volunteers working with our Youth are required to be fingerprinted and have a background check and are listed with our staff in the VIRTUS Program. The safety of our Youth is essential.

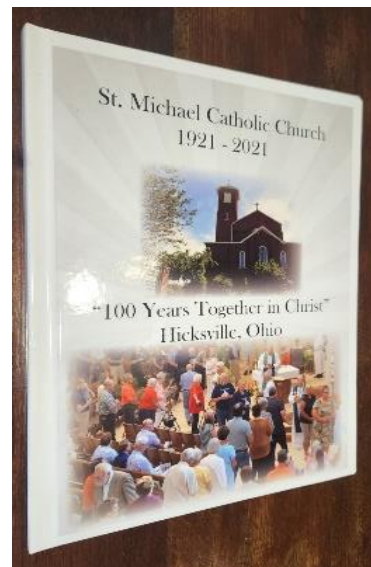
