





A Family Perspective ~ August 27th ~ 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time -- Like Jesus in today's gospel, we are seen by others in different ways. Perhaps the name our family gives us is closest to our true identity. They know us best. Who do they say you are?

This extreme anti-parent amendment (coming in Ohio on November 7th Ballot) is just the latest example of the ACLU's war on parental rights. The ACLU has a long and well-documented history of fighting against parental rights, including in Alaska and Indiana. The ACLU specifically calls out parental involvement on its website, saying it would restrict teenagers' access to abortion." Heritage Action recently released a report and video about the ACLU's attacks on parental rights in Ohio. In recent weeks, the ACLU has denounced parental notification requirements in schools, and the ACLU of Ohio's chief lobbyist confirmed that stance on Twitter.
