
Hospitalizations: Due to federal confidentiality laws, hospitals will no longer share patient information. Families must

<u>A Family Perspective ~ December 31st – Feast of the Holy</u> Family ~ The gospel today shows Mary and Joseph weren't 'perfect' parents. If you have ever been 'amazed' and 'astonished' at what came out of your child's mouth, then you are in good company. If there were times you 'didn't understand' your children or felt 'anxious' about their behavior so did Mary and Joseph. Parenting is tough but it is also the stuff of holiness.
