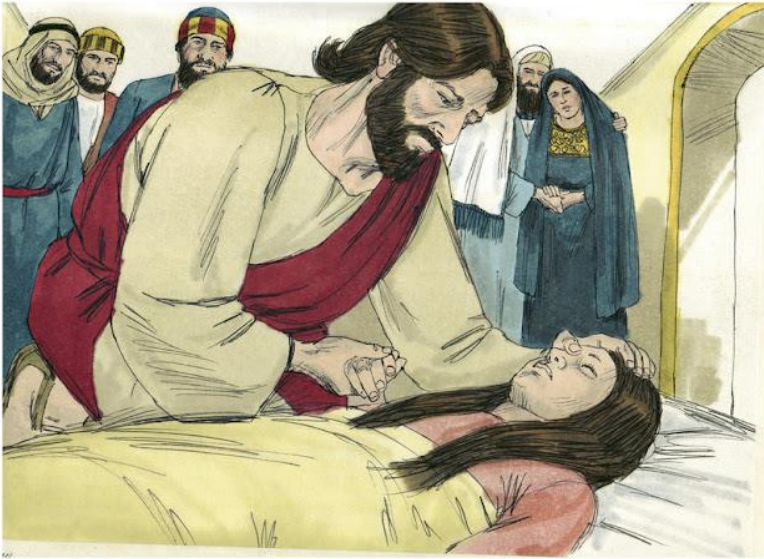

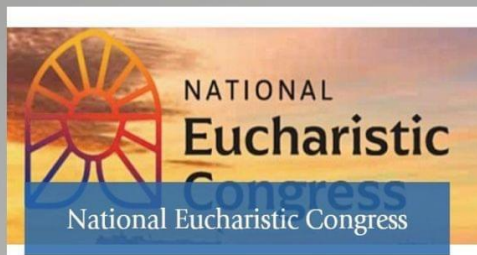

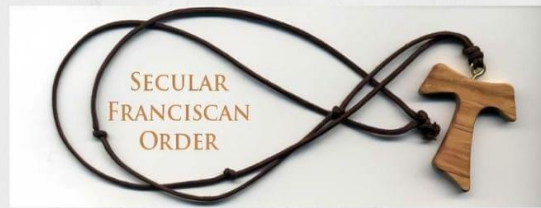
We will also be ready to answer questions about Faith, the Catholic Church, and life in general.
