

## Street Evangelization Team



We ask this through Christ our Lord.



#### 2024 Century Farm Award Applications Available




Catholic Charities is now accepting applications for Century Farm Awards.
This award designation honors Catholic families who have maintained a farm or homestead within their family for at least 100 years in the Diocese of Toledo, emphasizing well-preserved working farms.


