



This week's Ministry Spotlight ~

<u>CCD Teacher</u> – What does CCD stand for? Confraternity of Christian Doctrine. St. Michael's CCD Program serves pre-kindergarten through grade twelve. Classes are held on Wednesday evenings from mid-September to early May. Confirmation classes are held on Sunday mornings before Mass. The elementary program covers



prayer, the Sacraments, the Commandments, Scripture (the Bible), the Mass, the Saints and more, with different areas stressed in each grade. The junior high program concentrates on the history and teachings of the Church and preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. The high school program varies from one grade to the next, but deals with morality, decision-making, and how to live as a good Catholic in today's world. Our catechists are "people who have answered the call of the community to be instruments of instruction, formation and transformation." Our CCD teachers are not professional teachers. "God doesn't call the 'qualified'; He qualifies those who He calls." We are always looking for volunteers to put in the time and effort to instruct our youth in the Catholic Faith. We also need Assistant Teachers. Some training may be required. To help, you need only a willingness to give and learn and share the Catholic Faith. God (and the CCD program) will provide you with the tools you need. We need teachers, helpers and substitutes. All volunteers working with our Youth are required to be fingerprinted and have a background check and are listed with our staff in the VIRTUS Program. The safety of our Youth is essential.
